

Minutes
City Council Meeting
Monday, June 9, 2014 – 6:00 P.M.

The regular monthly meeting of the Mullins City Council was held Monday, June 9, 2014 at 6:00 P.M. in the Miles Community Center. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Mayor William L. "Bo" McMillan and Members of City Council, the City Staff, and the press. Present at the meeting were the following: Mayor William L. "Bo" McMillan, Council Members: Carolyn Wilson, Terry Davis, George Hardwick and Linda Schiavo; City Attorney Robert Corley, Street Supervisor Tarus Gilchrist, Fire Chief Robert Stetson, Police Chief Mike Bethea, Tom Crowell, Joe Graham, Public Access TV and many others.

1. Call Meeting To Order & Welcome: Mayor McMillan called the meeting to order and welcomed all present.

Invocation: The invocation was given during the Public Hearing.

2. Disclosure that local media has been informed of meeting pursuant to South Carolina Freedom of Information Act: Mayor McMillan stated the local media had been contacted regarding the time, date, and place of the regular scheduled meeting for June 9, 2014.

3. Approval of Agenda: Council Member Davis made a motion to accept the agenda as presented. Council Member Hardwick seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

4. Consent Agenda:

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Council Member Schiavo made a motion to accept the consent agenda. Council Member Davis seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

5. Old Business:

(a) Final Reading Ordinance, #14-007, "An Ordinance To Raise Revenue And Adopt A Budget For The Fiscal Year Ending in June 30, 2015"

Council Member Davis asked for an explanation of the funding for the demolition of the Old Brick Warehouse. City Administrator Hudspeth noted the Warehouse would be paid for out of the 13-14 budget.

Council Member Schiavo made a motion to accept the Final Reading of Ordinance #14-007, "An Ordinance To Raise Revenue And Adopt A Budget For The Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2015". Council Member Wilson seconded the motion. The Final Reading of Ordinance #14-007 was approved.

6. New Business:

Council Member Davis asked what was going on with the overgrown lots. Hudspeth stated the Ordinance has been posted in the paper and Code Enforcement has issued some certified letters.


Mayor McMillan stated Ms. Beth Bristow is the new Interim Director at the Mullins Chamber of Commerce.


8. Comments: Mayor McMillan stated there were no comments.
