

**Minutes
Recreation Committee Meeting
Wednesday, February 21, 2018**

The Recreation Committee Meeting was held Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 4:00 P.M. in the Raymond Pridgen Auditorium. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Recreation Committee and local media. Present at the meeting were the following: Council Members: Carolyn Wilson, Eddie Kitchen, Terry Davis, Recreation Director Allen Floyd, City Administrator David Hudspeth.

- 2. Disclosure that local media has been informed of meeting pursuant to South Carolina Freedom of Information Act**
- 3. Re: Department Review**

Recreation Director Allen Floyd stated the department had received grant approval for approximately \$35,752.73 in PARD money. Floyd presented a few projects for consideration. They included: landscaping at Dogwood Park, permanent brick signs at Gapway Complex and Dogwood Park, options for cooling the Park Street Gym – air conditioners/ventilating fans. The committee recommended the installation of ventilation fans as an interim solution for the gym. Installation of air conditioners would be discussed as part a major renovation to be paid for by the 1% sales tax. After much discussion the committee decided to have another meeting to discuss finalizing which project to under take.

Floyd stated Gapway Complex is in desperate need of a football scoreboard.

Floyd shared the concept of adding a complete renovation of the Park Street Gym to the 1% Sales tax that will be voted on in November. The request amount will be approximately \$1 million.
