

**Minutes
Police Committee Meeting
Monday, November 18, 2019**

The Police Committee Meeting was held Monday, November 18, 2019 at 12:00 P.M. in the Raymond Pridgen Auditorium. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Police Committee and local media. Present at the meeting were the following: Council Chairwoman Carolyn Wilson, Council Member Robert Woodbury, Council Member Jo Sanders, Captain Phil Mostowski, and Police Chief Mike Bethea.

Chairwoman Wilson recognized Mostowski. Mostowski stated there are 3 positions open in the department. There are 3 SRO's allocated for the school district. The department will also take on North Mullins Primary and McCormick if the Sheriff's Department doesn't take them.

Council Member Woodbury asked if the SRO's had other duties. Mostowski stated they do have other duties.

Chairwoman Wilson asked if the committee could do anything for the Police Department. Bethea stated the department has the best equipment in the County. All cars and officers have cameras. There are only 4 laptops. The department would need 13 laptops per the SLED guidelines.

Chairwoman Wilson talked about the litter issue in the City.

Council Member Sanders noted the junky yards in the City and Code Enforcement should enforce these issues.

Ordinances should be made for 18 wheelers on the side streets and Special Events.
