1. Call Meeting To Order & Welcome: Mayor McMillan called the meeting to order and welcomed all present.

6. Committee Reports

Fire Chief Robert Stetson presented information about Virgil Slagle performing an evaluation on the department. The cost of the evaluation is \$3,000.00.

Stetson stated the ISO rating went from 5-4. In order for this rating to stay as is, new equipment would need to be purchased.

The department is fully staffed at this time.

Council Member Davis asked if abandoned houses could be burned for training. Stetson stated he would check the list to see if any qualify.

A No Burn Ban should be implemented in the City. Stetson stated the current one could be amended. Council Member Woodbury asked for the citizens of Mullins to be notified of this change.

Captain Phil Mostowski introduced 2 new officers.

Council Member Sanders stated the fence at the Library hasn't been fixed. Sanders stated she had a quote for the repairs from John Merchant. Sanders also mentioned the Mayer's Garage property. The building would need to be taken off the Historic register.

Council Member Sanders asked why the new sign wasn't working. Mayor McMillan stated the delay was from Duke Energy.
