The City of Mullins has a year-round recreation program with a full-time director and 3 staff employees. Mullins is home to the Gapway Recreation Complex and Miles Recreation Center. The 30-acre facility features: 4 baseball fields, 8 tennis courts, 3 soccer fields and 1 football field.

Properties are cited and a notice is sent to the property owners. If the owners do not remedy the yard the City will go in and cut it. A fee will be added to the homeowners property taxes after the maintenance is completed to cover the cost of cutting.
