

CITY OF MULLINS
BUDGET WORKSHOP MINUTES
Tuesday, June 16, 2026

The Mullins City Council held a Budget Workshop on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, at 5:30pm in the Raymond Pridgen Auditorium, Mullins City Hall, Mullins, South Carolina. Council Members present were Mayor Pro Tem Carolyn Wilson, Luke Gasque, Albert Woodberry, Kindra Brewton-Pompey, Eddie Kitchen and Mayor Miko Pickett by telephone. Also, present was City Administrator Holly Jackson, Police Chief Philip Mostowski, and Captain Justin Turner.

1. CALL TO ORDER & WELCOME

Mayor Pro Tem Carolyn Wilson called the City Council Meeting to order at 5:30 PM at the Raymond Pridgen Auditorium.

2. FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT DISCLOSURE

Mayor Pro Tem Wilson announced that local media had been properly notified of the meeting in accordance with the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act.

3. NEW BUSINESS

(a). Report from Litigations & Lawsuits Committee was given by Council Member Kindra Brewton-Pompey. Chairman Pompey went over the agreement presented by WHP Training Towers for payment of their invoice with the City of Mullins. Chairman Pompey reported that the committee, with the recommendation of the Interim City Attorney, recommends the City Administrator execute the agreement on behalf of the City and that the Interim City Attorney draft an Ordinance incorporating the same by reference to be presented for 1st reading at the Council Meeting scheduled for June 23, 2026. Council Member Luke Gasque made said motion and Council Member Eddie Kitchen seconded. The motion passed with all ayes.

4. OLD BUSINESS

(a). FY27 Budget – City Administrator Holly Jackson presented to Council a balanced budget. She explained necessary budget cuts and keeping expected revenue amount realistic. Council discussed other opportunities to increase revenue including recreation fees, fines and new services. The balanced budget will be presented to the Public on Tuesday, June 23, 2026 and Council will have its first reading following.

(b). Penny Sales Tax Projects – City Administrator Holly Jackson informed Council that she had been called to a meeting at the County earlier in the day to go over all the information for the 2026 Penny Sales Tax Projects. That information will be attached to these minutes. As of the meeting 3 Council Members have responded to the projects survey. The list is due back to the county on June 26, 2026, the County will be putting values on each project before presenting it to the Penny Sales Tax Committee. The rest of council agreed to complete their survey and return it to the Administrator.
