City Council Budget Workshop

The Budget Workshop of the Mullins City Council was held Tuesday, June 28, 2022 at 5:30 P.M. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Mayor Robert L. Woodbury and Members of City Council, the City Staff, and the press. Present at the meeting were the following: Mayor Robert L.
