Recreation Director Allen Floyd gave an update on the Park Street Gym. Floyd stated there were work crews at the gym today.

Floyd stated 40-45 kids have been registered for football and soccer. The Recreation Department will also have cheerleaders, flag and tackle football. Soccer will begin on Monday, August 22^{nd} .

Floyd stated he has been in touch with Linda Scott to schedule times for tennis with Mullins High School. The cost to resurface 2 of the courts would cost around \$100,000.00. These courts could also be used for pickle ball.

The County donated a truck to the department.

Helmets have to be replace every 2 years due to being in safety compliance. The department currently has 60pairs of shoulder pads and 60-70 helmets. Helmets cost \$80.00 - \$100.00. Floyd asked that a post be made on social media for citizens to donate their old equipment to the department.
