

Minutes
Police Committee Meeting
Thursday, September 18, 2025

The special meeting of the Police Committee was held September 18, 2025, at 12:30 PM. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Chairwoman Carolyn Wilson, and Members of the Finance Committee, the City Staff, and the press. Present at the meeting were the following: Mayor Pro Tem Carolyn Wilson, Council Members: Luke Gasque, Kindra Brewton-Pompey, Police Chief Phil Mostowski, Captain Justin Turner.

1. Call Meeting To Order & Welcome: Mayor Pro Tem Carolyn Wilson called the meeting to order and welcomed all present.

2. Disclosure that local media has been informed of meeting pursuant to South Carolina Freedom of Information Act: Mayor Pro Tem Carolyn Wilson stated the local media had been contacted regarding the time, date, and place of the special committee meeting for Thursday, September 18, 2025.

3. Department Update:

Chief Phil Mostowski explained to the committee that the police/court software program has been bought by another company. The module was sold to ARMS. ARMS will cost an estimated \$15,000 - \$20,000 per year. The department has no choice but to search for a new program. The committee gave Chief Mostowski permission to get quotes and possibly get a contract so pricing could be included in next year's budget.

Chief Phil Mostowski noted the separation from City Hall and the Police Department. There was a SLED audit that would control access between City Hall and the Police Department.

4. Adjournment:

Council Member Luke Gasque made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Kindra Brewton-Pompey seconded the motion.
