

CITY OF MULLINS
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
Tuesday, May 19, 2026

The Mullins City Council held a special council meeting on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, at 5:00pm in the Raymond Pridgen Auditorium, Mullins City Hall, Mullins, South Carolina. Council Members present were Mayor Miko Pickett, Mayor Pro Tem Carolyn Wilson, Luke Gasque, Albert Woodberry, Terry Davis, Kindra Brewton-Pompey and Eddie Kitchen. Also, present was City Administrator Holly Jackson, Interim City Attorney James E Bain, Police Chief Philip Mostowski, along with many others in the audience.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Pro Tem Carolyn Wilson called the City Council Meeting to order at 5:30 PM at the Raymond Pridgen Auditorium.

- (a). PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE was led by Council Member Luke Gasque.
- (b). INVOCATION was delivered by Pastor Ayala of the Mullins Ministerial Alliance.

2. FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT DISCLOSURE

Mayor Pro Tem Wilson announced that local media had been properly notified of the meeting in accordance with the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Member Luke Gasque.
Invocation was given by Pastor Ayala.

3. EXECUTIVE SESSION – LEGAL.

(a). Pending Litigation / Mayor Miko Pickett vs. The City of Mullins. Interim Attorney Bain stated that Mayor Miko Pickett should recuse herself as this involved her. Mayor Pickett made all aware that she would be recusing herself from the discussion. A motion was made to go into Executive Session by Council Member Luke Gasque, the motion was seconded by Council Member Albert Woodberry.

4. RETURN FROM EXECUTIVE SESSION.

A motion was made to return to open session by Council Member Gasque and was seconded Council Member Brewton-Pompey.

A motion was made by Council Member Gasque to create a committee to deal with pending legal lawsuits and litigations and seconded by Council Member Brewton-Pompey.

Mayor Pickett made a motion to hire an attorney for \$185.00 an hour. There was no second.

Council Member Brewton-Pompey made a motion to nominate Council Member Woodberry for the Committee for Lawsuits and Litigations, seconded by Council Member Kitchen. Council Member Kitchen nominated Council Member Brewton-Pompey, seconded by Council Member Gasque. Council Member Kitchen nominated Mayor Pro Tem Wilson, seconded by Council Member Gasque. The Committee will schedule a meeting for Thursday, May 21, 2026.
