

**Minutes
Special City Council Meeting
Monday, November 19, 2018**

The Special Meeting of Mullins City Council was held Monday, November 19 2018 at 5:00 P.M. in the Raymond Pridgen Auditorium. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Mayor, City Council, the City Staff, and the press. Present at the meeting were the following: Mayor Bo McMillan, Mayor Pro Tem Phillips, Council Members Carolyn Wilson, Robert Woodbury, Terry Davis, Jo Sanders, Eddie Kitchen, City Attorney Robert Corley, City Clerk Felicia Sawyer

1. Call Meeting To Order & Welcome: Mayor McMillan called the meeting to order and welcomed all that were present.

Pledge of Allegiance: Pledge of Allegiance was given by Felicia Sawyer.

Invocation: Council Member Robert Woodbury gave the invocation.

2. Disclosure that local media has been informed of meeting pursuant to South Carolina Freedom of Information Act: Mayor McMillan stated the local media had been contacted regarding the time, date, and place of the Special Council Meeting for November 19, 2018.

3. Executive Session: Personnel Matter / City Administrator
