City Council Meeting / Teleconference
Tuesday, February 9, 2021

The monthly meeting of the Mullins City Council was held Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. via teleconference. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Mayor Robert L. Woodbury and Members of City Council, the City Staff, and the press. 1. Call Meeting To Order & Welcome: Mayor Woodbury called the meeting to order and welcomed all present.

Letters will be delivered to each resident in those areas.

Gilchrist stated the City has received a grant from Palmetto Pride for \$8,500.00. A grant in the amount of \$4,000.00 has also been received from MASC. These grants will purchase cones and equipment.

Council Members thanked Tarus for his hard work with assuming the responsibilities of the sanitation services.
