The monthly meeting of the Mullins City Council was held Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. The following were notified of the time, date, and place of the meeting: Mayor Robert L. 6. Committee Reports

Council Member Andre Campbell had nothing new to report.

Mayor Pro Tem Phillips had nothing new to report.

Council Member Kitchen stated the 300 trash carts have been delivered. They are being stored behind the Park Street shop. The work on Westridge is complete. Dixon Street will be completed next week. Joey Mincey will be cutting trees on the corner of James and Cooper Streets. Kitchen also stated there is no way to clean the storm drains without a Jetter. Public Works Director Gilchrist stated Sanitation Services is going good. Ray Mullins is out on Worker's Compensation.

Mayor Woodbury stated there would be approximately 25 garbage receptacles delivered in the next few weeks.

Council Member Mayo Phillips gave an overview of Recreation.

Council Member Terry Davis thanked the Recreation Department for allowing COVID shots to be given at the Park Street Gym. The shots will start back at the gym in December. Davis asked that the track be scrapped. Davis also asked for Smith Haven to be cleaned as well as treated for ant beds. Juneteenth Celebration will be held there on June 19th. Davis asked where the City is at pertaining to demolition of houses. The cost of a backhoe would cost the City around \$9,000.00 per month. There could be a CDBG grant for demolition. Mayor Pro Tem Phillips stated the owner is responsible for cleaning after burning or demolition. Interim City Administrator stated she would get a copy of the Ordinances from Greer & Myrtle Beach.

Council Member Kitchen stated the pool located at 1119 Sandy Bluff Road needs to be filled in because it is more of a landfill. Jason Lambert with DHEC has been called about the situation.
